PART-TIME PRE-ADMISSION SCREENING SPECIALIST

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS: Master's or Bachelor's degree in social work, clinical psychology, or counseling from an accredited university

Successful completion of course work which includes concentration in areas specifically related to assessment, diagnosis, and treatment of children, families, and adults with a clinical focus on mental health and systems theory, utilizing DSM V Criteria.

CERTIFICATION/LICENSURE: Current requisite professional certification or licensure, specifically LLMSW, LMSW, LLP, TLLP, LLPC, LPC, LLBSW, LBSW, RN or the ability to attain these credentials within an acceptable time frame.

EXPERIENCE: Minimum of two years clinical experience, including experience conducting clinical behavioral health assessment and providing intervention and treatment to individuals with a Mental Illness, Intellectual and Developmental disability, and/or children with Serious Emotional Disturbance, as evidenced by self-report and corroborated by references.

Is a psychologist, social worker, registered nurse, licensed/limited-licensed professional counselor, licensed or limited licensed marriage and family therapist, OR a human services professional with at least a bachelor's degree in a human services field.

RESPONSIBILITIES: As a member of the after-hours prescreening team, completes pre-admission screenings for individuals presenting in Shiawassee County with Medicaid or who meet indigent status who are seeking psychiatric hospitalization and develops alternative treatment plans in place of hospitalization if possible.

Coordinates and refers to community and natural resources to assist individuals with housing, benefits, food, clothing, medical assistance, or any other service that will assist in maintaining basic and safety needs.

Assists in the psychiatric involuntary commitment process.

Refers individuals to medically necessary or appropriate services based on the assessment of severity of illness and level of care needs, and coordinates with the Access center to monitor the referral who will ensure the treatment appropriate and necessary to the individual's present needs.

Maintains current and accurate documentation according to agency and third-party service and reimbursement standards and established agency practices and time frames.

Works with other agencies in the community to coordinate client services to address safety needs.

RANGE OF PAY:

Per Diem - Weeknight (5:00 pm to 8:00 am) rate of \$30 per diem when not required to report in person and \$60 per diem for a weeknight (5:00 pm-8:00 am) when required to report in person. Per diem for Saturday or Sunday (8:00 am to 8:00 am) when not required to report in person \$48 and \$96 per diem for a Saturday or Sunday (8:00 pm-8:00 am) when required to report in person. For each prescreen completed the rate of reimbursement is an additional \$75 each when conducted via video and \$90 each when completed in person.
